	spare. If you have a fever (37.5°C or higher), we will refuse you to take the test.
\bigcirc	Please refrain from taking the test when you feel sick.
\bigcirc	Wear your own face mask while you are at the test site. Examinees without a face mask will not be allowed
	to take the test.
	(You will be asked to take off the mask for personal identification.)
\bigcirc	Practice proper hand washing and hand sanitization are highly recommended.
\bigcirc	Limit conversation to a minimum and keep a certain distance from other people.
\bigcirc	Test rooms will be ventilated by opening the doors and windows so please wear your clothes which can
	handle high and low room temperatures.
\bigcirc	Only examinee is allowed to enter the test site. There will be no place to stay for your companion.
