

Precautions on the day of the 1st JLPT in 2023

Before taking the test, please be sure to check "Precautions when taking the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test" and please be especially careful of the following three points.

1. About using the parking or bicycle parking lot

There have been complaints that it is obstructing traffic by the examinees who have parked their cars or bicycles to the parking of a facility or on the street near the test sites or their nearest stations.

Please use public transportation to come to the test sites. When you park your car or bicycle at a station near your home, be sure to use a public parking, and do not park in the parking of nearby facilities or on the street illegally.

2. About smoking in and around the test sites

We have received complaints about smoking from the test sites and its surroundings.

Do not smoke in test sites where smoking is prohibited, on the streets, or in nearby facilities. Also, please do not smoke except at the specified places only, even in the test sites where smoking is allowed.

3. About improper behavior

In JLPT, the handling of cheating about the electronic devices* has changed from the 2nd test in 2022.

*Electronic devices: mobile phones, smartphones, smart watches, etc.

Yellow Card (caution)

Allowing your electronic devices to sound (ringing, manner mode vibration, or alarm) or the chime or alarm of your watch to sound **during the time allocated for instruction of the test (all section)**.

Red Card (disqualified and dismissed)

From the beginning of answering the test to finishing to check the answer sheet and question booklet by the proctor (all section),

① Allowing your electronic devices to sound (ringing, manner mode vibration, or alarm) or the chime or alarm of your watch to sound

② Using your electronic devices.

If the above manners are not observed, the applicant may be denied taking the test.

In addition, there are cases where the above-mentioned problems may make it impossible to rent a test site. In such cases, we will have no choice but to rent a test site in a distant location, which may cause inconvenience to examinees.
