# Precautions on the day of the 2nd JLPT in 2025 (December)

Before taking the test, please be sure to check "Precautions when taking the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test" on our JLPT website. In addition, please be especially careful of the following seven points.

#### 1. About electronic devices

## At the test site, using electronic devices is prohibited both during the test time and during breaks.

Please place all electronic devices (cell phones, smartphones, smartwatches, etc.) into the envelope. Do not open the envelope until the listening section (2nd period for N1 and N2, 3rd period for N3 to N5) has ended and the proctor says "ふうとうを あけても いいです。".



Please close the envelope's flap.



Using electronic devices during breaks is also prohibited.

## 2. About identity verification

Please bring one of the original of a valid Passport, Residence Card, or Individual Number Card (My Number Card).

You cannot take the test using copies of your Passport, Residence card, Individual Number Card (My Number Card), or other forms of identification.

# 3. Improper behavior

In JLPT, if we find examinees engaging in malicious cheating such as stealing test booklets, recording, or leaking test content, we will report them to the police for charges like fraudulent obstruction of business. Any items used for cheating (cheat sheets, electronic devices, etc.) will be confiscated and not returned. Furthermore, if for any reason the organizer determines that the validity of an examinee's score is questionable, JEES may invalidate your test score, not notify your test result or prohibit you from taking the JLPT in the future. Details about malicious cheatings are provided on the JLPT website under "Precautions when taking the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test" section, (7) and (8) of "3. Test precautions on the day of the test". Please be sure to read this information carefully











### 4. About coming to the test site

- ①The 2025 JLPT will be administered in AM and PM depending on the test level. The time to enter the test room and the time to start the test differ depending on the test level. Please check the time schedule carefully.
- ②Please use public transportation (train or bus etc.) to come to the test sites.
- 3 There is no waiting area before the examination.
- ④Only examinees will be allowed to enter the test site building.

  There is no waiting area for accompanying person.

### 5. About using the parking or bicycle parking lot

- ①Please do not park bicycles/cars in nearby facilities such as stations or stores near the test site. We have received complaints from users of stores and other facilities that they cannot use bicycle parking lots and parking spaces and those bicycles/cars are blocking the roads.
- ②When you park your car or bicycle, please be sure to use public or paid parking.
- ③Examinees arriving by bicycle, motorcycle or, car may be denied taking the test

### 6. About smoking in and around the test sites

We have received complaints about smoking from the test sites and its surroundings. Do not smoke at the test sites where smoking is prohibited, on the streets, or in nearby facilities. Also, please do not smoke except at the specified places, even at the test sites where smoking is allowed. If the above rules are not observed, examinees may be denied taking the test.

#### 7. Installation of Surveillance Cameras

Surveillance Cameras may be in use in classrooms of a certain size to prevent cheating. The captured video data will be properly managed and securely stored. After the examination, the video data will be deleted once it has been confirmed that no cheating occurred. It will not be used for any other purpose.

In addition, there are some cases where the above-mentioned problems may make it impossible to rent test sites. In such cases, we will have no choice but to rent test sites in a distant location, which may cause inconvenience to examinees.
